It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he is innocent and not named in the First

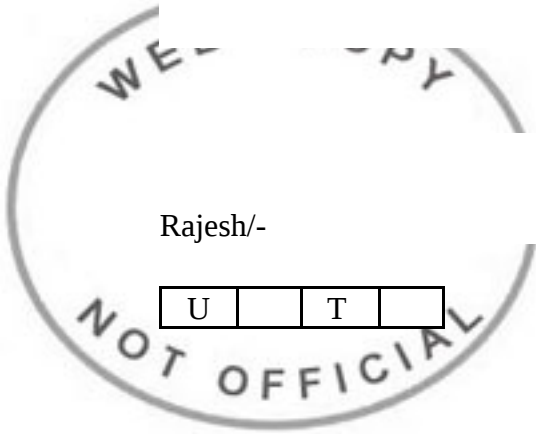
Information Report but on his confessional statement, which he confessed before the police after recovery of some silver articles, petitioner has been made accused. It has been contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that no Test Identification Parade has been done, as such, the petitioner be enlarged on bail.

Learned APP for the State, however, opposes the prayer for bail and submits that on his confessional statement the petitioner has been made accused.

Be that as it may, let petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dehri, Rohtas, in connection with Dehri (Town) P.S. Case No. 413/15, subject to the following conditions :

- i. One of the bailors will be the close relative of the petitioner.
- ii. The petitioner will not indulge in similar or in any other offence.
- iii. The petitioner will be well represented in the court.
- iv. In case of absence for two consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail, his bail

bond will be liable to be cancelled by the court concerned.
