Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections-3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 of the Immoral Traffic Prevention Act.

Petitioner is named in the first information report on
the accusation that he along with his wife was running brothel
from where, some women were caught.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner was earlier granted privilege of anticipatory bail by a
coordinate bench of this court but unfortunately, the petitioner
could not surrender before the court below in time and
subsequently, he was arrested and remanded on 30-09-2015 and
since then, he is languishing in jail custody.

Considering the above-said facts and circumstances

of the case as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 199 of 2011 to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya.
