Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel,
appearing for the informant.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections-452, 379 & other minor sections of the Indian Penal
Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

Petitioner is named but no specific overt act has been
attributed against him. Moreover, having more or less similar
allegation, some co-accused have already been granted privilege
of bail.

Contention on behalf of the petitioner is that the
present case has been lodged on account of village politics and as
a matter of fact, no one sustained any injury in the alleged crime.

Considering the above-said facts and circumstances of the case as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Ishakchak (Tilkamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 05 of 2016 to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VI, Bhagalpur.
