Heard Mr. Amish Kumar, learned Counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioner, and Mr. Vinay Kirti Singh, learned Government Advocate No.3, appearing on behalf of the State-respondents.

In view of the fact that on completion of investigation, police, having found, according to the Investigating Officer, no materials against the petitioner, has already submitted a *police report* in Pupri P.S. Case No.31 of 2016 in terms of Section 173(2)(i) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, this writ petition, made under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi, to hear the
