Heard Mr. Surendra Kumar, learned Counsel for the petitioner, and Mr. Ajay Kumar Rastogi, learned Additional Advocate General No. 10, appearing on behalf of the State-respondents.

With the help of this application, made under Articles 226 and 227 of Constitution of India, the petitioner is seeking specific enforcement of a contract agreement, dated 17.03.2015, which the petitioner claims to have with respondent No. 7.

Specific performance of contract cannot be enforced by filing a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The remedy of the petitioner lies in instituting appropriate suit in a competent civil Court of competent jurisdiction.

In view of the above, this application is dismissed.
