Learned counsel for the State submits that the writ application may be disposed off.

In view of the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed off with a direction to the respondent no. 9 to ensure that payment is made to the petitioner in terms of P.P.O. dated 09.09.2015 within four weeks from the date of production of a copy of this order before him.
