Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

This revision application has been filed for setting aside
the Judgment and order dated 19.8.2015 passed by the 3rd Additional
District and Sessions Judge, Sitamarhi, in Cr. Appeal No. 63 of
2015/14 of 2015 by which he has affirmed the order dated 30.6.2015
passed by the Juvenile Justice Board, Sitamarhi, in Juvenile Justice
Board Case No. 1330 of 2015 arising out of Dumra P.S. Case No. 236
of 2014 (G.R. No. 2518 of 2014), by which he has refused to release
the Petitioner.

In view of the statement of the alleged victim supporting
the factum of kidnapping and gang rape at the hands of the Petitioner,
I am not inclined to release the Petitioner.

The prayer for bail is rejected.

The application stands dismissed.
