2 18-01-2016 Petitioners being younger brother and parents of the husband of the victim are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/34, 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is killing the daughter of the informant after ten years of marriage for non-fulfilment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that on conclusion of the investigation, final form/charge-sheet was submitted against the husband and sister-in-law of the victim under Sections 498A, 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioners were not sent up for trial and final form was submitted, but differing with the final form, cognizance has been taken.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Araria(R.S. O.P.) P.S. Case No. 222 of 2013, G.R. No. 1303 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
