The petitioner has sought a direction to the respondent authorities to protect life and property of his old parents who are suffering physical torture and mental agony at the hands of the private respondents.

A perusal of the writ petition shows that the private respondents are agnates of the parents of the present petitioner. Inter se dispute with regard to the property between the parties cannot be

resolved in the present writ petition in the garb of threat to life and property of senior citizens.

If the petitioner has any grievance against the private respondents, he is at liberty to seek appropriate alternative remedy as may be available to him in accordance with law but no direction is called for by this Court in the present writ petition.

This writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
