Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The writ application was filed for a direction upon
the respondents to make payment of arrears of pension, full salary for
the period of suspension and interest on payment of gratuity as also
on commutation of pension.

As per the averments made in the counter affidavits,
the revised pension and gratuity has been paid to the petitioner and
for the period of suspension, the order in the departmental proceeding
provides for payment of only subsistence allowance.

A copy of the counter affidavit was served on learned counsel for the petitioner on 11.07.2016 and 14.07.2016. No rejoinder to the same has been filed.

In view of the aforesaid, the Court presumes that the admitted post retiral dues of the petitioner have been paid. That being the position, the writ application stands disposed off.
