ORAL ORDER

2 24-02-2016 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,
arises out of Kinjer Police Station Case No. 96 of 2015,
disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504/34
of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that
it is evident from the First Information Report that the
dispute arose over passing of sewerage pipe. He submits
that there is no allegation against the petitioner, except
that he had opened fire. There being no fire-arm injury on
any person, the case of the prosecution becomes doubtful.
The petitioner has no criminal antecedent, as stated in
paragraph 3 of the application.

Considering the submission, as above, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, Seojanam Paswan, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within four weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arwal, in connection with Kinjer Police Station Case No. 96 of 2015, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the police/Court, as the same may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.
