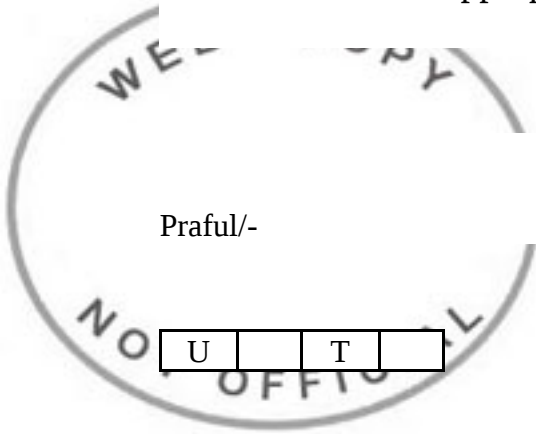
CORAM: HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE RAKESH KUMAR
ORAL ORDER

counsel who has voluntarily appeared on behalf of the informant,
