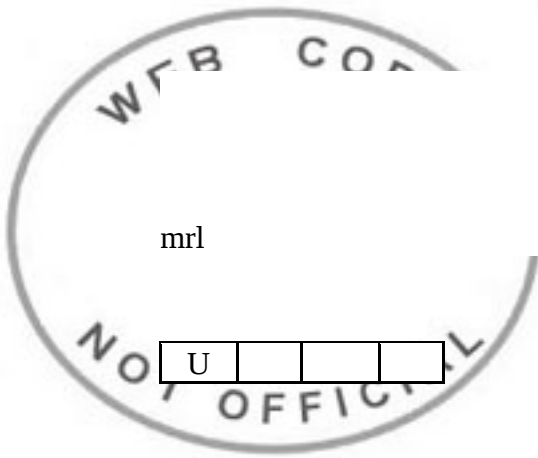
6 30-08-2016 Learned counsel for the appellant states that in view of
