Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 17.08.2016, the District Co-operative Officer, Samastipur and the District Treasury Officer, Patna are present and have filed their supplementary show cause. A rejoinder has also been filed on behalf of the petitioner. From the

pleadings it appears that the dues, which are admitted by the respondents, have been paid and further the documents on which they have relied for making such payment, copies have also been annexed to the supplementary show cause filed on behalf of opposite party no. 7.

In that view of the matter, the order of the Court dated 07.10.2015 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 7264 of 2015 stands complied with.
