Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case filed
under Section 47(E) of the Excise Act and Section 3 of the Mahua
Flower Act.

Allegedly 32 sacks of Mahua were recovered from
shop of the petitioner.

It is contended that petitioner has entered into an
agreement with the co-villagers for the produce of trees of
Mahua @ Rs.15,000/- per annum which is not for the purpose of
preparation of liquor rather it is for the use as cattle feed.
Petitioner claims to have clean antecedent.

Having regards to the facts and circumstances of
the case, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six

weeks from today in Rajauli P.S. Case No.244/15, the above named petitioner, Sitaram Lal shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000(Ten Thousand Rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Nawada subject to the conditions as laid down under sub-section(2) of Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
