**ORAL ORDER**

2      19-04-2016      Petitioners being parents, brothers and brothers' wives of the husband of the informant are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 341, 323 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfilment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that accusation against the petitioners is omnibus and general and the thrust of accusation is against the husband of the informant who is in custody. The petitioners claim to be separate from the husband of the informant. The petitioners are ready to allow the informant to enjoy her share of property in the matrimonial house.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, III, Gopalganj in connection with Baikunthpur P.S. Case No. 26 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The bail bonds of the petitioners shall be accepted on filing separate affidavit that they will allow the informant to enjoy her share of property in the matrimonial house. It is expected from the learned Court below to get the said affidavit transmitted to the concerned police station.
