3 11-04-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 461/379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that admittedly the name of the petitioner is not in the First Information Report, but subsequently on the basis of the confessional statement made by the co-accused Abhishekh, the name of the petitioner has been brought into the present case.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and his name has surfaced in the confessional statement made by the co-accused which has no evidentiary value, let the petitioner, in the event of his arrest / surrender within a

period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the each amount to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan in connection with Jamo Bazar P.S. Case No. 95/2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
