2 02-05-2016 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner being husband of the informant is apprehending arrest in a case filed under section 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 34 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfillment of dowry demands.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the marriage between the petitioner and the informant has been dissolved by ex-parte judgment dated 26-11-2015 passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Darbhanga in Matrimonial Case No. 69 of 2013.

Since the marriage has been dissolved, let the

petitioner be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga, in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 320/2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
