Date: 13-07-2016

The present writ petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 08.09.2015 passed in O.A. No. 200 of 2014 by learned Presiding Officer, Bihar, Patna by which learned Presiding Officer has ordered the petitioner to pay debt amount with interest amounting to Rs. 13,22,346/- together with pendent lite and future interest at contractual rate of interest from 30.08.2014 till realization of the entire sum due and recoverable with cost and for connected reliefs.

2. At the very outset, this Court takes note that the petitioner has adequate remedy against the impugned order of

the Debts Recovery Tribunal, Patna dated 08.09.2015 before the appellate forum for redressal of her grievances.

3. In the above view of the matter, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter. The writ petition stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy as may be available to her in accordance with law.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.
