Heard parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 409, 420, 188 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is contended that the petitioners joined in the year 2013 as Panchayat Secretary and the charge of records of the year 2003-04 was not given to them and, thus, they could not produce the records. In fact, there is no date etc. has been stated in the FIR anywhere as to the records of which year were required. It is also contended that there was no appointment of Primary Teacher after the joining of the petitioners.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, namely, Ram Janam Ram, Sikandar Ram, Parasnath Singh and Nageshwar Ram be released on bail in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today in connection with Kasma P.S. Case No.11 of 2016, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000 (Ten Thousand Rupees) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad subject to the conditions as laid down under sub-section (2) of Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
