Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 435 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 17 of C.L.A. Act.

Petitioner and some others are named in the first information report but informant only expressed his doubt against the petitioner and others. Petitioner does have criminal antecedent of two cases but in the present case, except suspicion, there is nothing against him.
