Heard.

The petitioners are aggrieved by an interlocutory order dated 14.01.2014/15.01.2014 passed in Land Ceiling Case No. 8 of 2013 by the respondent DCLR, Aurangabad, as contained in Annexure-8, whereby the petitioners being subsequent purchasers have been directed to be added as party respondents in the aforesaid land ceiling (pre-emption case).

The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent nos.4 and 5, at the very outset, submitted that the aforesaid Land Ceiling (Pre-emption) case No. 8 of 2013 has already been finally disposed of by order dated 07.07.2015 and claim of pre-emption raised on behalf of the respondent nos. 4 and 5 has already been allowed. In support of above contention, he

has produced certified copy of the aforesaid order dated 07.07.2015. Let the aforesaid certified copy of the order be kept on record.

In view of the aforesaid development, the present writ petition has become infructuous and is accordingly dismissed.
