There cannot be a direction upon the respondents to appoint the petitioner against the vacant positions of Assistant Teacher in the left over vacancy arising out of the original vacancy of 34,540.

2. There have been many rounds of litigation. Directions have been issued even from the Hon'ble Supreme Court besides the High Court. The modality has been worked out. The process has been initiated and the Bihar Staff Selection Commission is on the job. If the petitioner has made application and if he fulfills the requirement, his case will surely be considered and recommended or else the outcome

would be known only after Bihar Staff Selection Commission makes its recommendations.

3. Writ is disposed of with above observation.
