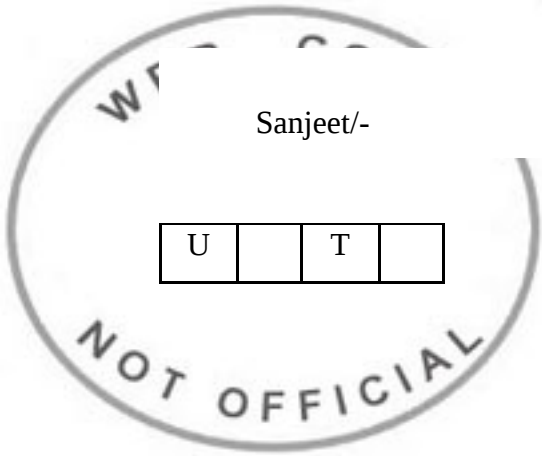
Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Saraiya
P.S. Case No. 44 of 2016 registered under Sections 308 of the
