In absence of clear and categorical material to show the engagement continuously or the authenticity of the petitioner's appointment in the very first place, the Court is not convinced with the wishy-washy kind of material, which has been brought on record to give a direction for consideration of recognizing the service of the petitioner under the State, so that he can start deriving benefit now on the basis of such material.
