Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the State raises a preliminary objection and submits that the dispute for which the petitioner has approached the High Court is amenable to arbitration before the Bihar Public Works Contracts Disputes Tribunal (hereinafter referred to as the ‘Tribunal’).
