5 23-02-2016 Mr. Manoj Kumar Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner
and learned counsel for the Bank are present and have been heard.

Although the petitioner prays for benefit arising from a
scheme of the Central Government known as Prime Minister
Employment Srijan Programme for upliftment of khadi and village
industry and that the petitioner having applied for loan under the
scheme has not been considered as such his application has
remained pending but considering the passage of time and in
absence of any information whether the said scheme is yet in force
the only order which this Court deems, fit and proper to pass is to

direct the Branch Manager, Central Bank of India, Branch- Benipur- Ashapure in the district of Darbhanga to consider the grievance of the petitioner and dispose of the same by a speaking order to be passed preferably within 3 months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

The writ petition is disposed of.
