The petitioner is languishing in custody since 17.07.2016 in a complaint case wherein processes were directed to be issued after cognizance being taken for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

The basic accusation is of torture.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that on 03.10.2014 the petitioner was forcefully married with the complainant. It is further submitted that informatory petition was filed by the petitioner on 12.11.2014 and thereafter the present complaint was filed on 25.11.2014.

Considering the nature of accusation and the informatory petition being filed by the petitioner's side at earlier point of time, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with

two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, I, Araria in
connection with Complaint Case No. 3404C of 2014.
