2 08-11-2016 Heard Mr. Ranjeet Kumar Singh for the petitioner and Md.
Ashlam Ansari, APP for the State.

The petitioner is facing prosecution in Motipur P.S. Case
No. 179 of 2016 registered under Sections 328/379 of the Indian
Penal Code and has approached this Court for grant of regular
bail.

On the date of occurrence, the informant along with his
vehicle (Scorpio) was hired by the petitioner. On way, the
petitioner offered cold drink to the informant which he later
consumed and became senseless. He came in sense in the hospital
whereafter the First Information Report was lodged. The police
upon search seized the said vehicle with the petitioner riding
thereon.

Contention of the petitioner is that on previous occasions,

he had also hired the vehicle, but without any such allegation. In fact, he was taking care of the vehicle when the police searched and arrested him.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer contending that not only the allegation is of administering stupefying substance to the informant, but the vehicle was also subsequently found occupied by the petitioner. He also points out that the petitioner is involved in two more criminal cases.

Considering the allegation and other materials reflected from the records including the impugned order, I am not inclined to grant him the privilege of bail. The prayer is rejected.

It will, however, open to the petitioner to seek bail again after six months in the court below itself.
