In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Begusarai Town P.S. Case No.07 of 2016, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 379, 385 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and under section 27 of the Arms Act.

From the FIR, it appears that it is basically a civil dispute with respect to the house and land of the informant.

Looking to the nature of allegation, let the petitioner- Ranjit Kumar @ Ranjit Kumar Gupta, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to

the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai, in connection with Begusarai Town P.S. Case No.07 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
