State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case under

Sections 341, 323, 308, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

There is a case and counter case.

It appears that there was free fight between the

parties. Petitioner No.1, Shiv Kumar @ Shiv Kumar Mochi, is the

informant of the counter case, in which petitioner no.2, namely,

Bal Saran Mochi, has also sustained injury on his head.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, in the

event of arrest or surrender before the court below within four

weeks from today, the abovenamed, petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.4000/- (Four thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hilsa, Nalanda in connection with Islampur P.S. Case no. 105 of 2016 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. with the further condition that petitioner no.1 would not physically absent for two consecutive dates at stretch, till two witnesses are examined.
