The Petitioner, who is the husband of the Opposite Party No.2, seeks quashing of the order of cognizance dated 25.5.2012 passed by the S.D.J.M., Shivhar in Complaint case No.96 of 2012.

Considering that the Petitioner seeks quashing on questions of fact which cannot be gone into at the stage of 482 Cr.P.C, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application is dismissed.

The Court below is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same positively within a period of six months from the date of receipt of this order without granting unnecessary adjournments to any party, for which reason he shall send a list of

the witnesses fixing specific dates for each witnesses for their examination along with a copy of this order to the S.P., Shivhar, who is directed to ensure the attendance of the witnesses on the date fixed by the Trial Court so that there is no further delay in the trial.

It is expected that the Complainant will co-operate in disposal of the trial.
