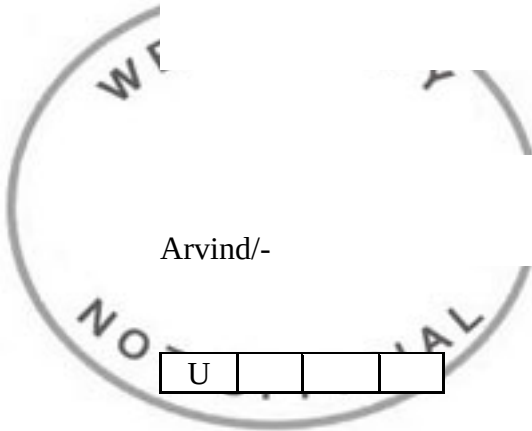
Permission is accorded.
