2. This application has been filed for modification of the
order dated 30.03.2016 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 9727 of 2016
arising out of Cr. Misc. No. 27584 of 2015 whereby and

with the additional condition that the petitioner will deposit a
sum of Rs. 1000/- per month regularly before the learned Court
below which shall be available for withdrawal by opposite party

his bail bond shall stand automatically cancelled.
