2 28-10-2016 The petitioner raising a grievance with respect to Pucca demarcation of his land filed a proceeding before the Deputy Collector Land Reforms, Masaurhi which gave rise to land Dispute Case No. 15/2013-14.

It is stated that the said matter was considered on different dates inasmuch as order was reserved, but no order thereafter is passed by the respondent-DCLR.

A counter affidavit is filed after service.

The counsel for the State drawing attention of the Court to the statements made in paragraphs 9 and 10 as also Annexure-A thereof submits that the DCLR has already disposed of the matter
