By way of the present application preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek quashing of the first information report in connection with Kadamkuan P.S. Case No.317 of 2012 registered under Sections 418, 506, 498A and 120B of the Indian Penal Code as also under sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the records.

3. Apparently, the allegations made in the first information report do attract ingredients of a cognizable offence.
