learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is named in the first information report but

submission on behalf of the petitioner is that prior to institution of

the present case, Navinagar P.S.Case No. 86 of 2015 was

registered against co-accused Wasim Akram and his brother-in-

law for missing of victim of the present case and in the aforesaid

case, victim was examined under section 164 of the Cr.P.C in

which she disclosed that she had solemnized her marriage with the

aforesaid co-accused Wasim Akram. It is further contended by the

learned counsel for the petitioner that the victim again eloped with co-accused Wasim Akram but the informant implicated the petitioner and several other persons in the present case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate,1st class, Aurangabad in connection with Navinagar P.S.Case No. 147 of 2015.
