Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 409, 406, 420, 422, 120B, 504,

506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant is said to have supplied stones, sand, etc.

amounting to Rs. 4,60,250/- to co-accused and so far as petitioner

is concerned, it is only stated that he got introduced the co-accused

to the informant. Moreover, even if the prosecution story assumed

to be true, then also, it is only a case of civil dispute.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as

well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Sanjay Kumar, Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jamui in connection with Chandradeep P.S. Case No. 96 of 2015.
