2 18-03-2016 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code, section 47(a) of Excise Act and Rules 3 and 5 of Bihar Excise (Mahua Flowers) Rules, 2006.

The prosecution case is that 24 bags of Mahua flower each containing 40 kilograms was recovered from the house of Lalita Devi when she suggested that the petitioners stored the bags giving an impression to her that the bags contain maize.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that admittedly the recovery has been made from the house of Lalita Devi and Statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Daudnagar, Aurangabad in connection with Haspura P.S. Case No.22 of 2016 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
