Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal
Code and Sections 41, 42 and 52 of the Indian Forest Act.

It is contended that 206 pieces of ‘Khair’ wood, one
tractor alongwith trailer were recovered from the field of co-
accused Krishan Kuer, however, the petitioner has no concern
with the alleged recovery rather it belongs to one Rajoo Patel, who
had unloaded the same in the field of the petitioner as his tractor
developed some mechanical trouble. It is urged that the said Raju
Patel had filed an application before the court of Chief Judicial
Magistrate, Motihari for release of his ‘Khair’ wood. It is claimed
that antecedent of the petitioner is clean.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, namely, Umesh Singh be released on bail in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today in connection with Paharpur P.S. Case No.198 of 2014, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000 (Ten Thousand Rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran subject to the conditions as laid down under sub-section (2) of Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
