ORAL ORDER

2 30-03-2016 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner was refused bail by the order of this
Court dated 3.3.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. 49161 of 2014.

Considering the period of custody and the
undertaking of cousin brother of the Petitioner namely, Amit
Saurabh, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/-(Five thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each or any other surety to be fixed by
the court concerned to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, 1st
Class, Patna, in connection with Rajiv Nagar P.S. Case No. 26 of
2014, subject to the conditions, (i) That one of the bailors will be a
close relative of the Petitioner who will give an affidavit giving

genealogy as to how he is related with the Petitioner and the other shall be the cousin brother of the Petitioner namely, Amit Saurabh. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the Petitioner. (ii) That the bailor shall also state on affidavit that he will inform the court concerned if the Petitioner is implicated in any other case of similar nature after his release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding for cancellation of bail on the ground of misuse. (iii) That the Petitioner will give an undertaking that he will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if he fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, his bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse. (iv) That the Petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.
