was present to press this application. Again after recess when

the case is called out no one appears on behalf of the

petitioner. However, learned counsel for the State is present.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 363, 365, 366(A) and 120(B)/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that her minor daughter was
kidnapped by Rahul Kumar, Babita Devi and the present
petitioner who is father of Rahul Kumar for the purposes of
marriage. Materials have been brought before the court to the
effect that this victim claims herself to be a major lady,
entered into the marriage with her own volition.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let petitioner, Jhunkhun Kamkar @ Jhunkhun Kamakar , be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in Brahmpur (Krishna Brahm) P.S. Case No. 198 of 2015.
