4 26-02-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. representing the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Khaira
P.S. Case No. 190 of 2013 registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 120(B), 363, 341, 323, 307, 379 and 504 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR. It is submitted
that the name of the petitioner has come in the confessional
statement of co-accused Ratan Chaudhary, the victim after his
release has not stated the name of the petitioner vide para 22 of the
case diary and without any legal and tangible material the
petitioner is suffering in custody since 24.09.2015. Co- accused
Sheo Shankar has been allowed bail vide Criminal Misc.

No.24090 of 2014. The learned A.P.P. submits that the petitioner has also confessed his guilt.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, considering the period of detention of the petitioner now he is directed to be released on bail on execution of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned C.J.M., Jamui, in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 190 of 2013, subject to the conditions that one of the bailors must be near relative and another having sufficient immovable property within the territorial jurisdiction of the court concerned and the petitioner shall remain present on each and every date during trial and the default on two consecutive dates on his part without any reason shall disentitle the petitioner from privilege of bail.
