Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner being the husband of the victim is
languishing in custody since 25.10.2015 in a case registered for
the offences punishable under sections 498A, 302/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Prosecution case is of killing the daughter of the
informant after nine years of marriage by causing burn injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that accusation is omnibus and general and on conclusion of
investigation final form (charge-sheet) has been submitted under
section 306 of the IPC. A statement to that effect has been made in
paragraph 8 of the petition, which reads as follows :-

*"10. That chargesheet/Chalan no.06/2016 dated 20.01.2016
in connection with this case is filed under section 306 of the
I.P.C. against petitioner and his father Om Shankar Sao."*

It is further submitted that the father of the petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail vide Cr. Misc. No. 6701 of 2016.

Considering the fact that investigation has already concluded and charge-sheet has been submitted under section 306 of the IPC, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Danapur in connection with Maner P.S. Case No.454/2015.

Learned court below will be at liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner if he defaults for two consecutive occasions.
