Since a modality is already in place, based on a directive issued by a Division Bench earlier, this Court will neither add or subtract anything from therein. The Bank do have an obligation to verify the position of the petitioner keeping in mind his date of superannuation, the settlement, if any, made in favour of the petitioner and do the needful within the framework of the modality. It will be

also advisable for the Bank to communicate to the petitioner the position with regard to his claims within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order.

Writ stands disposed of with above observation.
