2 12-04-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 25.06.2015 passed by the Assistant Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, Kishanganj Circle, Kishanganj under Section 8 of the Bihar Tax on Entry of Goods into Local Areas for Consumption, Use or Sale therein Act, 1993 read with Section 25 (3) of the Bihar Value Added Tax Act, 2005 for the period 2014-15.

The said order is amenable to remedy of statutory appeal and no jurisdictional issue has been raised by learned counsel for

the petitioner in the matter.

In the aforesaid circumstances, the writ application is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail of statutory remedy of appeal. In case such an appeal is filed within a period of four weeks from today then the appellate authority shall consider the same keeping in view the fact that a large number of similar matters of brick kiln pending in this Court have recently been dismissed.
