169 which has been affirmed by the Division Bench in the

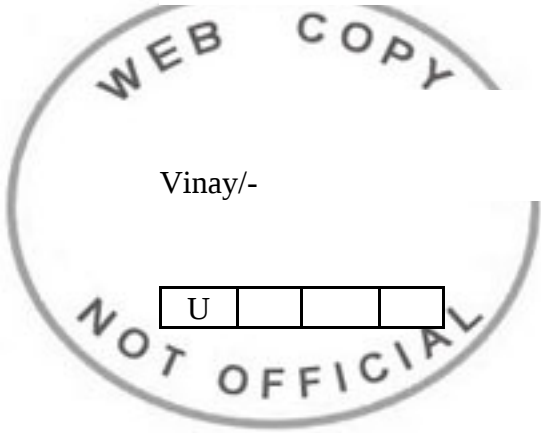
case of Kumod Kumar and others V. Bihar Staff Selection
