ORAL ORDER

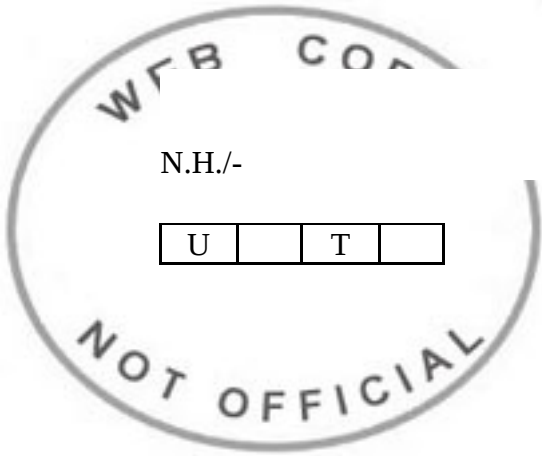
2 25-01-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
