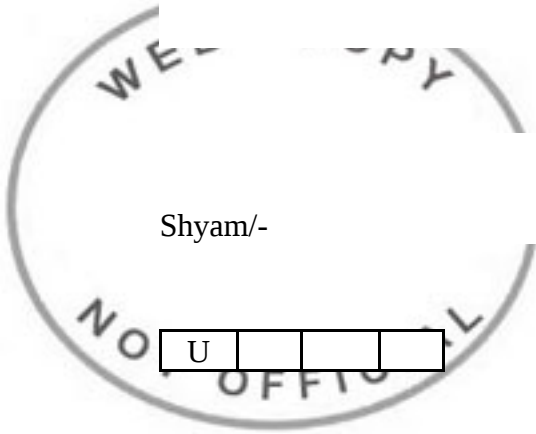
2 12-05-2016 Heard the parties.
