In this writ application, made under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, in the form of a Public Interest Litigation, the grievances expressed by the petitioner is to the effect, *inter alia*, that CD-4 machine, installed at the ART Centre, in Shri Krishna Memorial College Hospital (SKMCH),

Muzaffarpur, has not been operational for some technical defects.

By filing their written counter affidavits, the respondents have brought on record that the said CD-4 machine has, now, become operational.

In view of the above, we close this writ petition, with a direction to the respondents to ensure that the said machine is kept operational and all such necessary steps, as may be warranted, shall be taken to maintain the said CD-4 machine.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to move this Court with appropriate application, in future, if situation so warrants.
